All are recognized and honored for their learning and growing as we honor children graduating from one class to the next.

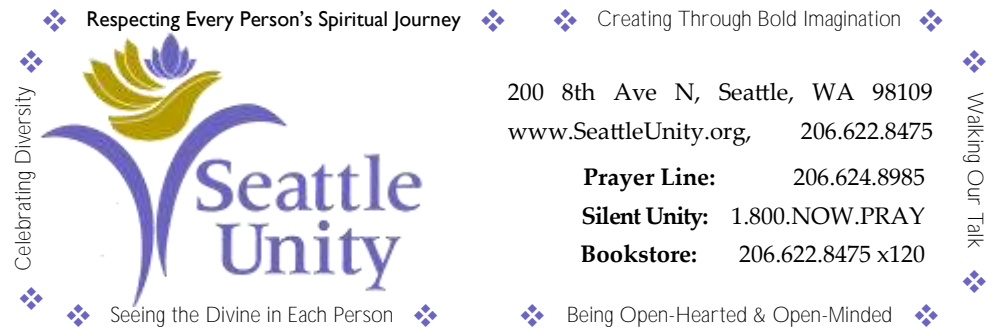
This year will include a candle lighting as each child walks through a beautiful floor labyrinth created by Heidi Nathe (YOU Sponsor). Parents are welcome to attend.
